

Information on the processing of authorised representative services for foreign manufacturers

ASSUMPTION OF YOUR OBLIGATIONS (INITIAL DISTRIBUTOR AND COLLECTOR) WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE AUSTRIAN DEPOSIT SYSTEM

As part of the introduction of a deposit system for disposable plastic and metal beverage containers from the 1 January 2025, affected companies are obliged to make financial contributions to ensure the collection, recycling and disposal of single-use beverage packaging. The environment of individual registration, reporting and payment obligations is complex and very dynamic.

Foreign companies that supply directly to private Austrian end consumers must appoint a domestic authorised representative as the initial distributor and collector in order to participate in the Austrian deposit system. Foreign companies in the EU/EEA that sell to resellers can appoint an authorised representative and assume the obligations of the Austrian importer/distributor.
